





What should be done about the now-empty bungalow lot?

The recently vacated area our bungalows used to occupy is up for renovations—but for what? The decision-making process is especially painstaking when it comes to the redecorating of our school.




"I see people playing football in that area, so we should get a small field, just one to go throw the ball around."
